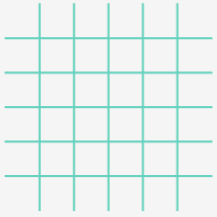

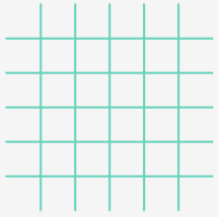

MARISSA TOTH

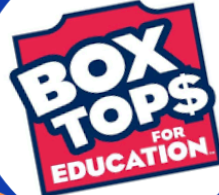

Connect a Walmart Account
